The group agreed to the following consensus items and statements:

Vision: San Diego desires an airport or airports that are reasonably located to conveniently address the San Diego Region's transportation needs.

Purpose: The San Diego Regional Airport Citizen's Coalition actively engages the community in the process of airport planning to address the region's transportation needs.

Operating assumption: The airport or airports need to make air travel accessible to 80% of people in the region in 45 minutes or less during normal airport operating hours.

Activities: the San Diego Regional Airport Citizen's Coalition fosters dialog and activities that explore alternatives to the work of the San Diego Regional Airport Authority.

August 6, agenda summary

- **Welcome and Introductions:** Ray Peters welcomed the participants to the second San Diego Regional Airport Citizen's Coalition meeting. Ray gave recognition and praise to the talented website development team of Paul Grimes and David Hogan. David reported there have been about 15 to 20 "hits" a day so far, but we are unable to determine who has been accessing the site.

Paul did have success in getting information about prior San Diego Regional Airport Authority facilitated meetings which include the 48 page “ChoiceWork Dialogues Final Report” listed below. Lesley brought the Executive Summary from that report to the meeting. Ron suggested each group member carefully read the full report. The group questioned whether we are being moved down a pre-determined path.
- History and Purpose: The group discussed the various discussion points from the Fly into the Future Dialogues. The group also reviewed and discussed the Future of the San Diego Region’s Airport – ChoiceWork Dialogues with County Residents, August 2004 Final Draft. The group then agreed to our purpose statement. “The San Diego Regional Airport Citizen’s Coalition actively engages the community in the process of airport planning to address the region’s transportation needs.”
- Review of last meeting. The group agreed with the “vision and consensus items as written.
- Action Planning: We agreed to design 5”x7” handout sheets with the “vision, purpose, assumption and activities” statements that each member can use to explain who we are and what we do.
