Meeting Protocols: Coalition members agreed to the following meeting protocols:

- Decisions and action plans are made by group consensus. Members will not take unilateral actions that have not been agreed upon.
- Members respect those who are speaking and avoid participating in side conversations.
- No one person should monopolize the discussion.
- Coalition moderator will facilitate the meetings and assist group is supporting the agreed upon protocols.

Report on meeting with RAA's Joe Craver: Those in attendance reported on the meeting with Joe Craver July 10. Mr. Craver said that the ballot language cannot be changed at this point. The RAA is not locked in on the West Miramar area so East Miramar is still a possibility. The ballot language is sufficiently broad as to allow for discussion of East Miramar. It also allows for flexibility and growth. In response to our question about the Airport Land Use Compatibility Act, Mr. Craver said that if fixed wing aircraft were removed, then there is not a problem with compliance with the Land Use Act. If the fixed wing aircraft remain, the only option is East Miramar. Paul indicated that Mr. Craver offered some support in terms of charts, boards, etc. for our future presentations.

Position Paper: Tom presented a very thoughtful and thorough paper that we can use for our future public presentations. The group reviewed this in detail. With a few modifications, Paul will post on our website as our official position paper.
